

RIASSUNTO

Viene descritta una nuova specie di *Paracerceis*, *Paracerceis dollfusi*, proveniente da Dakar (Senegal).

Paracerceis dollfusi n.sp. si distingue da tutte le altre specie del genere per la presenza di caratteristiche carenature dorsali e di un unico dente nell'incisura pleotelsonica del maschio.

SUMMARY

***Paracerceis dollfusi*, new species of Isopod (Sphaeromatidae, Eubranchiatae) from Senegal.**

A new species of *Paracerceis*, *Paracerceis dollfusi*, found in Dakar (Senegal) is described. *Paracerceis dollfusi* n.sp. differs from the other species of the genus by the presence of the peculiar dorsal longitudinal carinae and of a single denticle in the male pleotelsonic notch.
