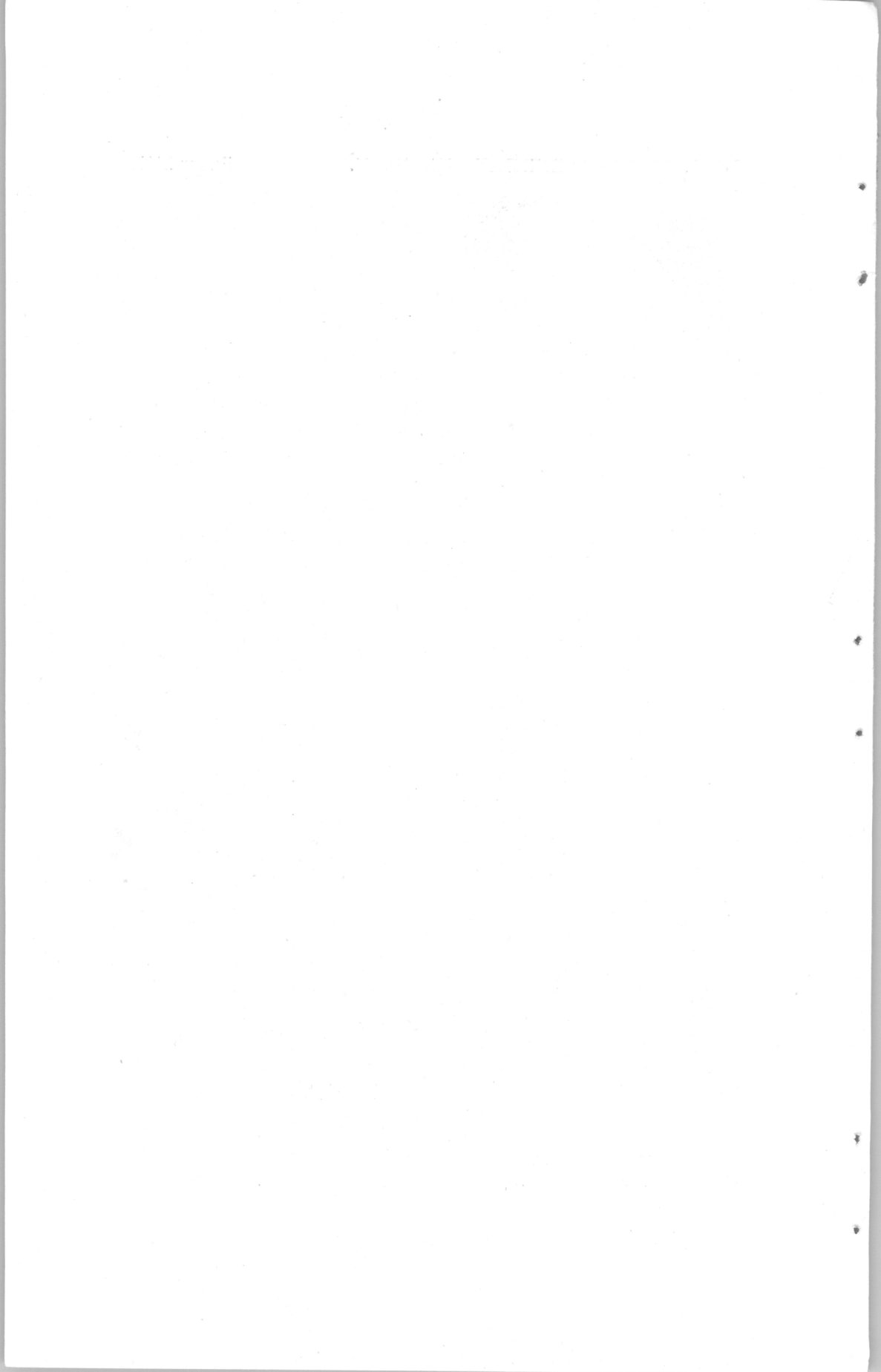

EXPLANATION OF PLATE LVIII.

*Penæopsis monoceros* (Fabricius).

- Fig. 1. Lateral view of an immature male cotype of Haswell's "*Penæus mastersii*" in the collection of the Macleay Museum, University of Sydney. Carapace and rostrum 26 mm. long (rostrum slightly damaged at tip).
- Fig. 2. Thelycum of a young female in the collection of the Australian Museum (Reg. No. P.4287 *part*), measuring 17 mm. from the tip of the rostrum to the end of the carapace.
