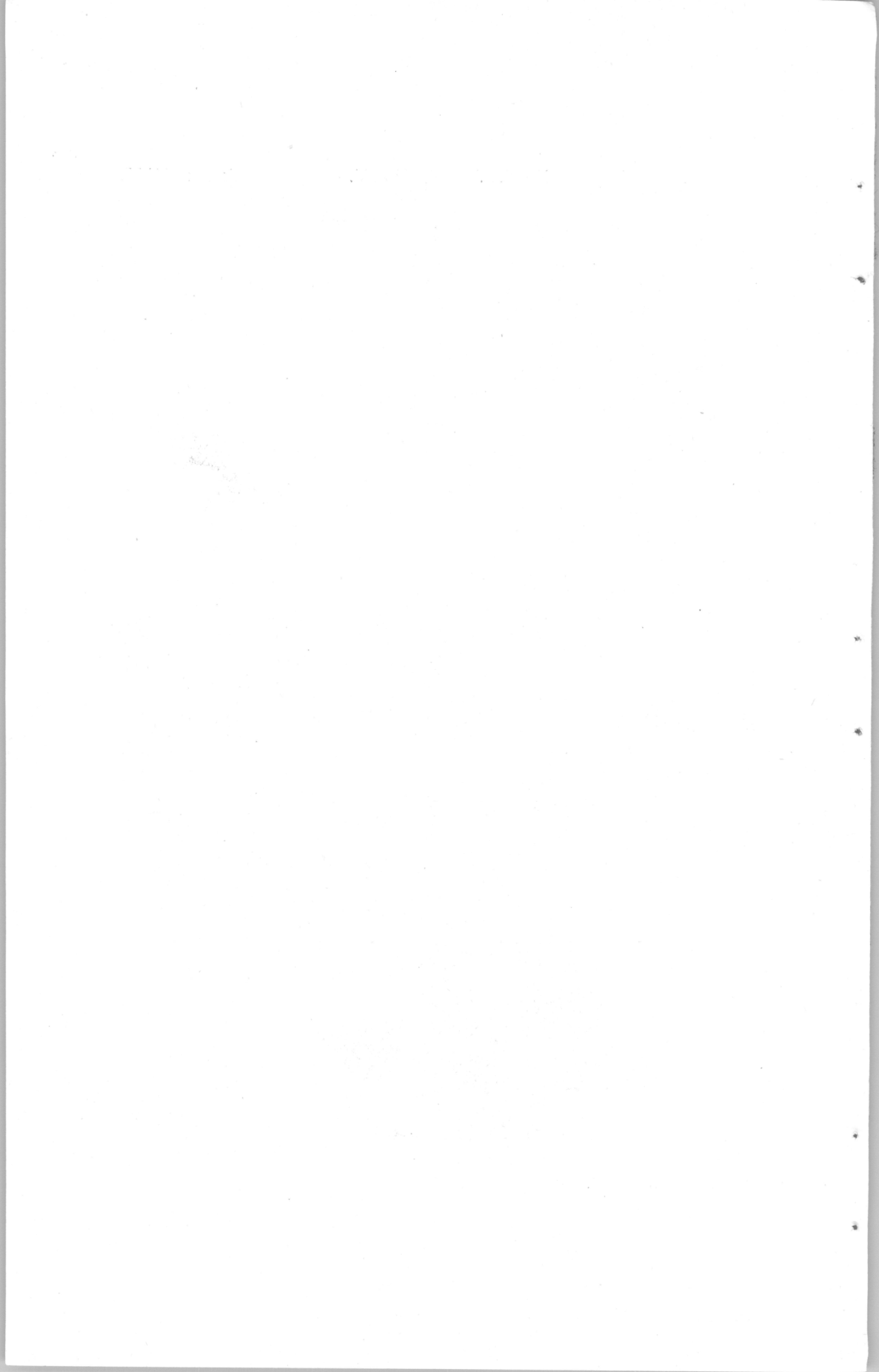


EXHIBIT 101-101-101

1. The first part of the document is a list of names and addresses of the persons who have been notified of the hearing. The names are listed in alphabetical order and include the names of the parties to the hearing, the witnesses, and the members of the hearing panel. The addresses are listed in the same order as the names.

2. The second part of the document is a list of the questions that will be asked of the witnesses. The questions are listed in the order in which they will be asked and include questions about the facts of the case, the witnesses' knowledge of the facts, and the witnesses' opinions about the facts.

3. The third part of the document is a list of the exhibits that will be presented at the hearing. The exhibits are listed in the order in which they will be presented and include copies of the documents, photographs, and other items that are relevant to the case.

4. The fourth part of the document is a list of the rules that will govern the hearing. The rules are listed in the order in which they will be applied and include rules about the order of testimony, the presentation of evidence, and the conduct of the hearing.

5. The fifth part of the document is a list of the procedures that will be followed at the hearing. The procedures are listed in the order in which they will be followed and include the opening of the hearing, the presentation of testimony, the presentation of evidence, and the closing of the hearing.

Panæopsis endeavouri sp. nov.

Fig. 1. Lateral view of the female holotype. Carapace and rostrum 56 mm. long.

(NOTE.—Antennular flagellum drawn from another specimen.)

Fig. 2. Thelycum of female holotype.

Fig. 3. Petasma of a male specimen (Reg. No. E.6687), measuring 48.5 mm. from the tip of the rostrum to the end of the carapace.
